



## Penguin Conservation



Globally, SEA LIFE is home to 5 species of penguin, from the majestic king penguin which stands nearly a metre tall, to the smallest penguin in world - the fairy penguin.

Our penguin breeding programmes are some of the most successful in the world with over 20 penguin chicks being born every year! Our SEA LIFE teams also support projects in the wild that help protect penguins and their homes.

### Our penguin breeding programmes – SEA LIFE global

- Our penguin breeding programmes allow us to maintain a sustainable and healthy population in our aquariums that can help educate and inform our visitors about penguins and the threats they face in the wild.
- We breed 5 species of penguins including the African penguin (*Spheniscus demersus*) which is Critically Endangered and the humboldt penguin (*Spheniscus humboldti*) which is listed as vulnerable to extinction.

### Supporting penguin conservation – SEA LIFE global

- At Kelly Tarlton’s SEA LIFE aquarium in New Zealand we are working with New South Wales National Parks and Wildlife Service in Australia to support habitat rehabilitation, clearing of weeds and re-planting in an area that is home to a local fairy penguin population.
- Weymouth SEA LIFE Park provides donations to ‘Sphenisco’, an organisation that works to protect humboldt penguins in their natural habitat in South America.
